Mrs Crosland enjoys counting songs and rhymes. This week we would like you to learn '5 little Ducks'



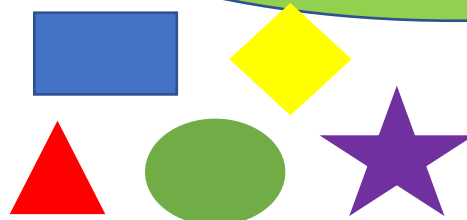

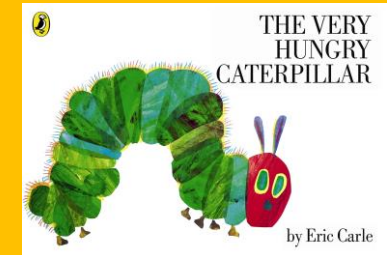
Three tips for Reception Readiness
