Year 3 have had lots of fun this week making bird feeders and looking out for the various birds on live watch. Well done Year 3!

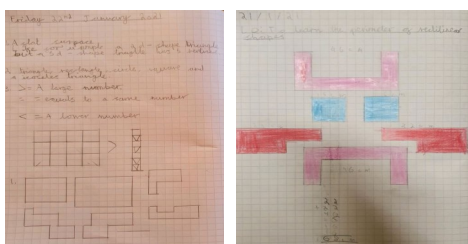
In Maths this week Year 3 have been busy completing some fantastic work with fractions. Brilliant work Year 3!

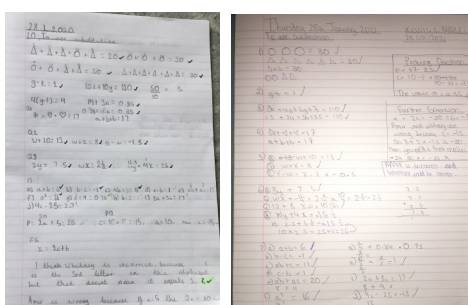
