Early Years



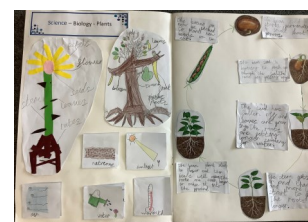
In EYFS we decorated our envelopes in preparation for our good deeds. We are excited to see our good deed for the day, and try hard to follow them.

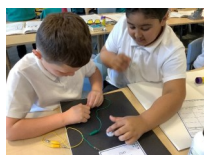


KS2
