Even though this half term is particularly short, at only 5 weeks, we have many great learning experiences planned here in school. We are excited to announce that we have recently introduced a new synthetic phonics scheme called **Little**Wandle Letters and Sounds which will ensure all of our children become fluent readers. The deadline to complete the form is Friday 2nd February. Please note, places are limited however there will be further opportunities next half term if you are unsuccessful this time. Once the form has closed you will be informed by text message whether your child has a place.

All of the after school clubs are free of charge. Clubs finish at 4.10pm and all children should be collected by an appropriate adult from Luck Lane Primary at this time with the exception of children in Year 5 and Year 6 who have been given permission to walk home.

World Book Day

We will be dressing up for World Book Day to celebrate our love of reading and to swap recommendations of our favourite books. Your child can come to school representing their favourite book or book character. Please do not spend lots of money on costumes, there will be prizes for the most creative.

Uniform Reminder

We have a simple but effective uniform and visitors comment on the high standards we keep. We value the support that parents/carers give in keeping up to this.

Our uniform consists of:

- Sweatshirt, or cardigan, plain agua with school logo (required and purchased from uniform shops)
 - White polo shirt (required and purchased from supermarkets and uniform shops- no logo)
- Black or grey trousers (no leggings as trousers), skirt or pinafore dress. (required and purchased from supermarkets and uniform shops)
- Plain white or grey/black socks or tights (required and purchased from supermarkets and uniform shops)
- Year 5 and Year 6—Optional shirt and tie with V-neck school jumper or cardigan (can be purchased from uniform shops)
 - Black sensible footwear which does not include different coloured logos, boots, flimsy plimsols or sandals (required and purchased from supermarkets and uniform shops)

In terms of jewellery, we allow only one pair of small plain studs in metal, one in each ear lobe (no jewelled studs, no hooped earrings). Children must be able to remove their own earrings for PE and sports.

Class Dojo is our main form of communication with lots of information and photos shared on class dojo regarding what's happening in school.

Messages can be sent to your child's teacher and the school office on the app.

School Meals

We are delighted to share with parents and carers that at Luck Lane we use a dinner system called CYPAD.

CYPAD can be accessed by logging in to ParentPay here you will be able to see the menu choices and order your child's lunch. If your child has a home packed lunch this can be chosen as an option. Lunches can be chosen up to 10 weeks in advance.

Currently, the cost of a school meal is £2.60 a day (£13.00 a week) which must be paid in advance.
